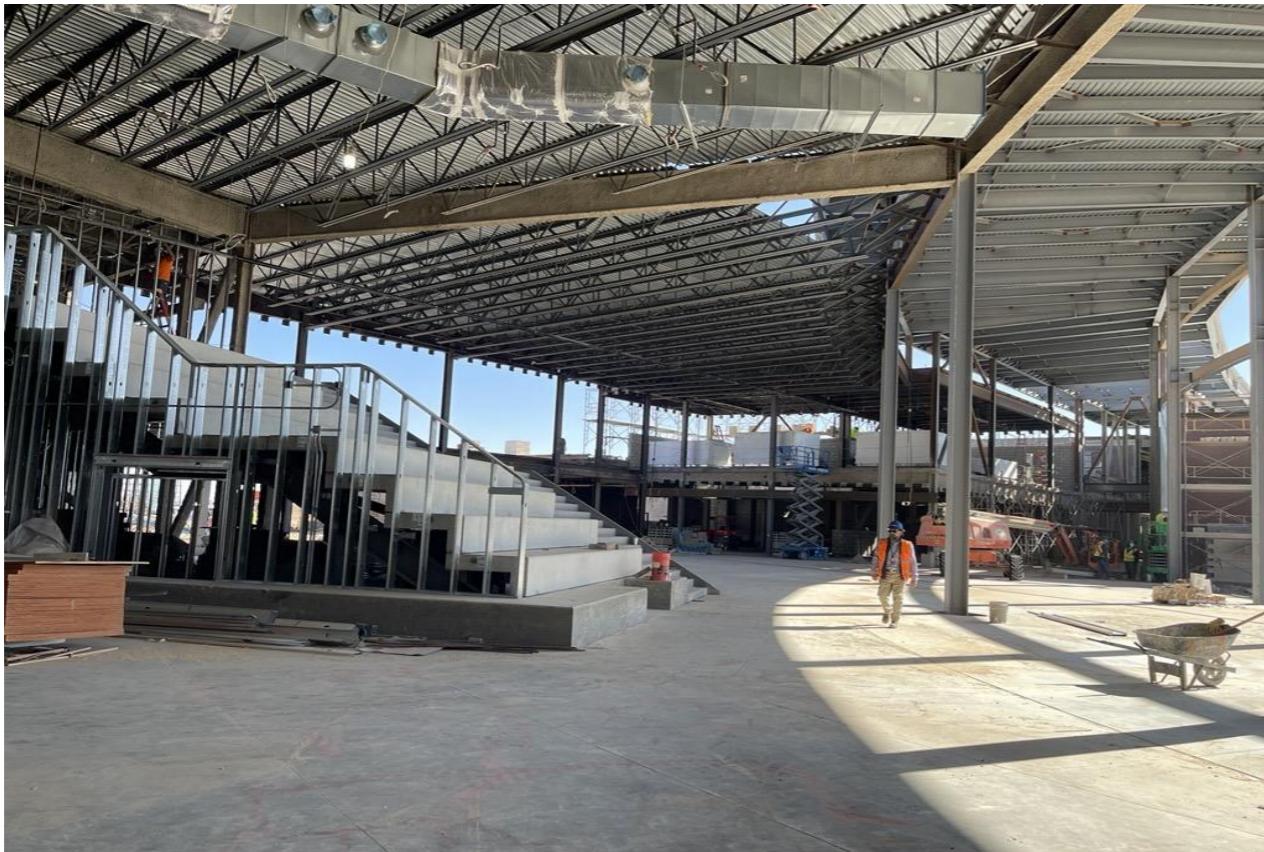

Construction Update

Summary

- Fly and Travis roofs are nearing completion. Contractors for both projects are working on final tasks. Inspection walkthroughs will take place at Burleson and Zavala this week. This walkthrough will allow the contractors to gather remaining tasks for completion.
- A contractor recommendation for roofing package 2 will be presented this evening. A schedule will be developed and work will be assigned accordingly.

Ector County ISD

Priority 1 and 2 Projects – Travis Elementary School



- Terrazzo team has mobilized and will start work soon.
- Installing finishing touches to plumbing, faucet replacements, and tile.
- Cleaners are onsite and started in south wing.
- Adjusting and replacing damaged ceiling grid and tile in north wing.

Technology

PA, Bell, Alarm and Clock Refresh

- The PA, Bell, Alarm, and Clock Bond Project continues to progress as scheduled.
- To date, 13 campuses have been fully completed, with upgraded systems now operational.
- The next campuses scheduled for installation are Cameron and Alamo.

Surveillance

- The Surveillance Camera Bond Project is nearing completion, with installations substantially finished across district campuses and facilities.
- The project is now in its final stage, with the last remaining site being Ratliff Stadium. Once work at Ratliff Stadium is finalized, Phase 1 of the districtwide surveillance project will be complete.
- Phase 2 will begin shortly after and will add additional door access cameras to campuses, further strengthening districtwide security.

Notes:

- Moved MS land costs and matching budget from land project to MS project totaling \$794,898.
- Moved budget from MS Uniforms to Priority 1 & 2 of \$685,000.
- Unused funds of \$10m from the Transportation Facility and unused funds of \$3,760,117 from land purchase were reallocated to the CTE High School.
- CTE High School donation from PSP of an additional \$10 million is accounted for separately in Fund 468 so that it is not commingled with bond funds.
- Moved budget of \$10m to CTE High School. Moved budget from land of \$4m for Transportation facility.
- Unused funds from land purchased were reallocated as follows: MS \$794,898; CTE HS \$3,760,117, \$48,648 for JROTC facility, and \$4m for Transportation facility.
- Moved from land project to ROTC facility to cover slight increase in cost of \$48,648.
- Moved budget to Priority 1 & 2 of \$685,000. Uniforms will be purchased with general funds.
- Moved budget of \$14,200 from one light project to the other.
- Moved budget of \$14,200 from one light project to the other.
